The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and recreation of the Town of St. John, Indiana was held on July 24, 1972. President James Thiel, with the Pledge to the Flag opened the meeting. All four board members were present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the June 1972 meeting were read and approved as read.

Mrs. Pietrzak attended the July Town Board meeting, and said that there was nothing to report concerning the Park Board.

Our attention was then focused on the task of locating spots on the map of St. John in an effort to adopt a Master Plan for Parks. Approximately ten (10) sites were marked off as good locations, and a motion was made by Mrs. Pietrzak that we table any further planning of park areas until next month when Mr. Smith would be here to confer with us.

Mr. Spring brought up the subject of a Master Park, however, the other three Board members were of the opinion that at this time it was not feasible to plan that far into the future, since the thing our Town needs at this time are more neighborhood parks. At this point, discussion was held as to what equipment should consist of in neighborhood

parks. It was thought that this could be specified in some type of ordinance pertaining to Town parks.

Mr. Spring then requested that any members of the Board who could be at Larimer Park the next day at approximately 6:00 p.m., be there to confer with Mr. Mike Grimmer to plan the location of the shelter.

The meeting was adjourned until August 28, 1972.
