The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and Recreation of the Town of St. John, Indiana was held on Monday, September 25, 1972. The meeting was opened by President James Thiel, with all four board members present as well as Mr. Eugene Smith.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the July and August meetings were read and approved as read.

Mr. Spring presented the Board with blueprint drawings of the shelter to be built in the Park. The plans were studied and approved.

Mr. Smith suggested to the Board that a list of things needed by the Park Department be submitted to each of the Town's organizations. A motion was made by Mrs. Pietrzak that we determine immediately out needs and submit them to the Town's organizations. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Jernberg and carried. The following needs were listed in the order of their importance:

1. 42 inch oval culvert – 16 feet minimum.
2. Shade trees – no Poplar, Weeping Willows or Elms.

3. Drinking fountain.
4. Picnic benches
5. Playground equipment
6. Tennis court

A model ordinance pertaining to parks was read completely and the members of the Board were asked to re-read it before the next meeting and to give consideration to any additions that should be made or to any deletions.

Mr. Smith advised the Board that a Master Planner has been hired by the Town, and that we will be meeting with him shortly.

ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned until October 23, 1972.
