The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Town of St. John, Indiana was held on March 26, 1973.

The meeting was called to order by the President, Mr. Richard Spring, with the Pledge to the Flag.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the February meeting were read and approved as read.

Mrs. Pietrzak announced that the light has been installed in the Park, and that the culvert has been delivered to the site. Mr. Spring said that he would contact Mr. Monix about getting the culvert installed.

Also the Jaycees have inquired about where the sand should go that they want to purchase for the baseball field in Larimer Park.

After some discussion about the shelter to be constructed in Larimer Park, Mrs. Pietrzak moved that plans be completed in entirety for Larimer Park without waiting for the

Town's Master Plan to be developed. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Jernberg and carried.

The Board members thought that it might be nice to include plans for a few picnic benches and a fire pit in the Park.

Mr. Spring announced that a transfer of funds was made from the Water Department to the Park Department in the amount of \$236.00. This money will have to be paid back when we receive our tax draw.

Mr. Spring said that when the culvert is installed he would like to see some type of screening put over each end to prevent some child from crawling in and getting injured, and the Board agreed that he should speak to Mr. Monix about this.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned until April 23, 1973.
