The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Town of St. John, Indiana was held on April 23, 1973, with all four board members in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the March meeting were read and approved as read.

Several announcements were made by Mr. Spring. One of them being that the culvert at Larimer Park is to be installed during the week. The next announcement was that the Jaycees inquired about whether the Park Board would be in favor of the ball diamond being built up with some type of fill before the same for the diamond is put down, in order to assure that the same will stay in place. No one on the Board object to this.

Fifty dollars (\$50.00) has been received from the St. John Junior Women's Club to be used for the development of parks in the Town. It will be deposited in the non-reverting capital fund for Parks.

An ordinance that was recently adopted by the Village of Lansing, Illinois, outlining a subdivider's dedication of parkland was read. An article appearing in a Chicago paper was also read reporting on the filing of suit by a subdivider against the Town of

Naperville, Illinois. The suit contests the Town's right to pass such an ordinance. After discussion, it was the decision of all the Board members to table any action on such an ordinance until we hear the outcome of the suit still pending.

Mr. Spring suggested that we think about areas where land can be acquired in St. John for park property. The question of how this land could be purchased was brought up, and Mr. Spring said that he would go to the Town Board to ask if some of the Federal Revenue Sharing money could be used.

A letter was read from the Women's Club in Town, sending their regrets that they would not be able to make any donation to the Park this year.

ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was then adjourned until May 28, 1973.
