The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Town of St. John, Indiana was held on November 26, 1973, with all four members in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the October meeting were read and approved as read.

The following announcements were made by Mr. Spring:

1. Mr. Dewey Snow is to go out to the Park and put a pad in with six inches (6") of stone on the basketball court to get it ready for paving.
2. He had been out riding around looking for suitable park sites and pointed out several on the town map that he thought would be suitable.

Mrs. Pietrzak stated that she thought before any further discussion was held with reference to obtaining park sites, that we meet with the Town Board members to ascertain just how much development they had in mind for parks. The other Board members concurred with her and Mr. Spring agreed to set up the meeting.

Recreation of the town children was discussed and it was felt that the Junior and Senior High age group was being left out of any activity that had been planned in the past by the Town's civic organizations. Mrs. Pietrzak offered to look into the idea of an indoor skating party at the Omni for this age group and Mr. Spring offered to look into a model airplane show for all age groups. Both projects will be reported on at the next meeting.

The meeting was adjourned until January 28, 1974. There will be no meeting in December because of the Christmas holidays.
