The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Town of St. John, Indiana was held on April 22, 1974, with three members in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the March meeting were read and approved as read.

The following announcements were made by Mr. Spring:

1. The flags for the Park are being repaired and will be raised and flown until November 1, 1974.
2. Mr. Michael Muenich is checking with the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation (BOR) to see what the proper way is to deed over the Park property.
3. The old church that was discussed at a prior meeting is being moved by the Catholic Church in town, and Mr. Muenich upon checking into the title for the cemetery has found that it is owned by the Diocese of Gary. There are approximately four (4) acres.

Drain tile for the Park was discussed and it was agreed that this should be installed in the Park this summer so that the park will be in shape for use.

The feasibility of presenting a resolution to the Plan Commission and to the Town Board was discussed. This resolution would state that approval of any subdivision should be halted until the Town's Master Plan is adopted. No decision was reached about presentation of such a resolution.

A report was given on the Ice Skating Party by Mrs. Pietrzak. She stated that about 125 children attended the party. However, only about 20 of these were of high school age, and recommended that if ever is done again, perhaps grades 4 through 8 be invited. A total of \$160.00 was donated from local organizations and paid to the Omni 41 Sports Center, leaving the balance of \$100.00 still to be paid from our budget.

The meeting was adjourned until May 27, 1974 at 7:30 p.m.
