The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Town of St. John, Indiana was held on Monday, August 26, 1974.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

In the absence of the Secretary, the minutes of the July meeting were read by Mrs. Jernberg. The minutes were approved as read.

Mr. Gerald Hancock, 12042 West 97<sup>th</sup> Lane, was appointed to fill the vacancy of Mr. James Thiel, and he was now introduced to the other Board members, and welcomed by them.

Mr. Hancock mentioned that there is an electric or telephone line sagging near the pond in the Park. Mr. Hancock said he would take the responsibility of notifying the proper authorities on having this remedied.

After discussion with reference to the culvert to be installed in the Park, Mr. Hancock volunteered to contact Michigan Wisconsin Pipeline Company about obtaining some kind of used pipe for a culvert.

The plan proposed by the Town Engineer was studied and discussed and was rejected because too much of the park's area would be taken up with this type of plan.

A bike route was discussed and the route it is to take will be tabled until various routes can be studied further.

Mr. Spring has proposed that he will talk to Mr. Frank Schilling about using the land behind the shopping mall for a roadside park.

It was proposed that Ordinance No. 377 be amended as follows: "All unencumbered and unused budget funds for properties and land acquisitions and capital improvements can be transferred to the non-reverting capital fund". This amendment will be presented to the Town Trustees for action.
