The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Town of St. John, Indiana was opened with two members in attendance on July 28, 1975.

Mr. Bill Glenn, Programming Director for the Lake County Department of Parks and Recreation, and Mrs. Kathy Durochik, our Summer Recreation Director, were also present.

Mrs. Durochik gave a report on the Summer Recreation Program. Mrs. Durochik will present a summary on what was done during the summer program at the September Town Board meeting. Twenty-five (25) people helped with the program. An average of one hundred (100) children attended daily. Mrs. Durochik suggested that next year that scrap material be brought from home by the children, in that way saving expenses. Mrs. Durochik also reported that she was informed that the Boy Scouts will be putting additional garbage cans in Larimer Park.

Mr. Glenn suggested that next year we apply for a Director for the recreation program through CETA, enabling us to have a six to eight week program, with one program in the afternoon at the other park. If application is made to CETA, it should be done at least two months prior o the dates of the program. We should contact Greg Jones from

Crown Point. Youths from our community could apply for summer jobs to help in the program, by first contacting us and then applying to CETA.

Mrs. Jernberg brought up Mrs. Durochik's salary as Recreation Director. We have a check for \$52.71 from the Lions Club to be used for our Recreation Program, and Mr. Spring will contact Betty Siedelmann to see how much money is left in the budget. A definite amount will be decided upon at a later date.

Mr. Spring said he would like to look into the possibility of having a hayride or a sleigh ride for this winter.
