The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Town of St. John, Indiana was held on Monday, October 27, 1975, with two members in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the October 1975 meeting were read and approved as read.

Mr. Spring reported that we are going to try and blacktop the basketball court this year. Hopefully, we will get it donated. We will try and install an additional pole and backboard, so a dull basketball court will be available.

Mr. Spring reported that the baseball diamond has been done over. There has been an additional drainage line from the top of the hill connecting to the existing drain system, \$93.90 has been paid, \$40.00 for trencher, \$53.90 for the four-inch pipe.

Basketball court cost of \$532.25, \$114.00 for labor and \$418.25 for stone (\$119.50 tons of grade #8). We contracted the work to R & M Excavating Company.

Mrs. Jernberg made a motion to pay R & M Excavating Company. Mr. Spring seconded the motion. Motion was passed.

Mr. Spring reported that we would try and get sand in the pavilion, so that we can build up a pad, then concrete will be installed in the pavilion.

Mr. Spring reported he had a meeting with Mr. Kasenga on October 18, 1975, at Mr. Kasenga's request, to discuss the possible purchase of ten acres of land located at the north end of Olcott Avenue, south side of Forrest, east of Kardel Drive. It is part of Timberlane subdivision. Mr. Kasenga's asking price was \$25,000.00.

A vacancy still exists on the Park Board. We are working on filling the vacancy.

ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned until November 24, 1975 at 7:30 p.m.
