The regular meeting of the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Town of St. John, Indiana was held on Monday, November 24, 1975, with two members in attendance. The Park Board has two vacancies.

Mr. Spring read a letter he received from Mr. Hancock resigning from the Park Board. Mr. Spring made a motion to accept his resignation, Mrs. Jernberg seconded the motion. The motion was passed.

Mr. Spring reported that R & M Excavating has been paid.

Mr. Spring reported that we won't be finishing the basketball court this year, the reasons being:

- 1. Financial status of the budget is depleted.
- 2. Winter has set in.

Two companies were contacted for the blacktop, Beihlman Company and Walsh & Kelly. Their estimates were between \$1,000.00 to \$1,200.00. Mr. Spring recommended waiting for spring when Route 41 is blacktopped. We can get the basketball court done in conjunction with that.

Mr. Spring reported that the Lake Central Carpenter Shop has agreed to build a bridge for Larimer Park. This bridge will be constructed for pedestrian walking only. Supplies must be purchased by the Park Board, design and assembly will be done by the carpenter shop of Lake Central High School.

Mr. Spring held a meeting with Bill Glenn from the Lake County Department of Parks and Recreation. We will begin proceedings to apply for federal funds for the land that Mr. Kasenga has made available to us.

We are in the planning stages to see if we could have a seven to eight week summer program of arts and crafts, with a recreational director to service four communities.

The meeting was adjourned until December 22, 1975 at 7:30 p.m.
