APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Spring reported we will lease two and a half (2 ½) acres from Fran Thiel for \$1.00 a year.

Mr. Spring reported we will have a meeting on May 5, 1976 with Bill Glenn.

Mr. Spring reported the Park Department received a check from the St. John Jaycees for \$50.00. Mr. Spring will send a thank you note to them.
