A special meeting was called by the Park Board to meet with Mr. Bill Glenn on May 5, 1976 at 8:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the April meeting were read and approved as read.

Mr. Glenn wanted to know what we expected of the Quad Town Community Coordinator. After some discussion, it was decided the duties of the Coordinator would be:

1. To coordinate the recreational activities for the summer.
2. Set up winter program.
3. To apply for matching funds for the land that Mr. Kasenga will donate to the Park Board. All of the paperwork has to be downstate by September 1<sup>st</sup>.
4. Work on the B.O.R. project to show to the Civic Club, to see what funds would be available to use if they would donate the Civic Club Park to the Park Department.

The Summer Recreational Program will be held July 12<sup>th</sup> through July 30<sup>th</sup> (3 weeks). It will be a morning program, 9:00 – 12:00 noon, 5 days a week, ages 6 – 12 years old.

Registration will be held on Monday of each week. \$1.00 for each week you attend. If they are coming all three weeks, you can pay the \$3.00 on the first Monday.

Mrs. Catterton said she will check on two different people that might accept being activities Supervisor for the three weeks.

Mr. Glenn reported there would be a track meet at Lemon Lake Park around July 29<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Glenn said we should check the water line on the land that Mr. Kasenga will donate to us, we need three appraisals, also estimates on what we want on the lot.

Mr. Spring will check to see if we can use Civic Club Park for our Recreational Program.

Mr. Spring will check on the signs for our bike route.

Mr. Glenn reported there would be a tour of the County Parks on May 16<sup>th</sup>. He will let Mr. Spring know more about the tour later in the week.

We will have to curtail the activities on Friday morning at Larimer Park, so that the Park can be cut.

Mr. Spring reported Dewey Snow will bring in two (2) loads of dirt to build the diamond up.

Mr. Glenn reported the cost of the Coordinator will cost \$1,283.32 starting June 1<sup>st</sup> till the end of the year. Also, we can contact Greg Jones from CETA for workers for our Summer Program.
