The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by President Bernard Ducat.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The minutes of the May 20, 1982 meeting were read and approved.

**OLD BUSINESS**

- 1) Deeds to Parks – Lancer Estates Park. Ron Estep reported that Mr. Dennis Kwiatkowski appeared before the Town Board on June 14, 1982 and said, “That he would not turn over the deed until the Town paid him for the water line tap-ins”. Homestead Park – Town Board still discussing terms of deed with developers.
- 2) Pavilion for Larimer Park – Carolyn Walsko reported that she is still developing this project.
- 3) Park Rules Signs – Ron Estep will contact painter and ask him to expedite this matter.

- 4) Bleachers – Richard Spring reported that Mr. Monix was ordered by the Town Board to remove Park Board bleachers from Security Federal Field and place them in the Town Board controlled Civic Park. When Mr. Spring asked Mr. Monix to place the bleachers back at Security Federal Field, Mr. Monix refused, saying that the Town Board ordered him to place the bleachers at Civic Park.

### **ASSIGNMENTS**

- A. Summer Program – Carolyn Walsko reported that this year's summer programs will commence the weeks of July 19<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>. The cost will be \$2.00 per child per week. Each additional child in the same family will cost \$.50.
- B. Fitness Program – Ron Estep reported that he is working on some programs with the Southlake YMCA.
- C. 1983 Budget – A special session will be held on June 24, 1982 at 8:00 p.m. to review and pass the budget.
- D. Park Maintenance – Carolyn Walsko reported that a player's bench was broken at Larimer Park. Mr. Spring will respond. Discussion was brought up about replacing the slide at Larimer Park. Mrs. Walsko and Mr. Spring will look into the matter,
- E. Public Relations – Carolyn Walsko had no report.
- F. Liaison to Town board – Ron Estep had no report.
- G. Softball & Baseball – Bernard Ducat reported that the baseball season is in full swing. It was also reported that home plate was stolen from Larimer Park. Mr. Ducat and the St. John Jaycees will be installing a backstop on the Dick Thiel property on June 19, 1982.
- H. Senior Citizens – This program has been referred to the St. John Jaycees.
