The meeting was called to order at 7:34 p.m. by President Bernard Ducat.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the September 16 and October 21, 1982 Board meetings were read and approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Park Signs – Mr. Estep reported that he had requested the signs for Homestead Park be completed as soon as possible. The sign maker had replied that he would make a definite effort to complete the signs. - 2) Mr. Spring made a motion to spend \$45.00 to buy a Jaycee Creed Banner for the St. John Jaycees. Seconded by Mrs. Walsko. Motion did not pass. Voting aye – Spring and Ducat; voting nay – Estep and Walsko. Mr. Estep stated that we would split the cost of the banner with Mr. Spring.
