The meeting was called to order at 7:38 p.m. by President Bernard Ducat.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the March 17, 1983 Board meeting were read. Motion made by Richard Spring, seconded by Ron Estep to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried 3-0.

OLD BUSINESS

- 1) Larimer Pavilion – Motion made by Ron Estep, seconded by Bernard Ducat, to contact R. Schilling Construction to build a concrete slab and apron in Larimer Park for \$2,480.00. Motion carried 3-0.
- 2) Park Signs – Ron Estep reported that one sign has been installed on the west end of Homestead Park. The second sign will be installed in about 2 or 3 weeks.
- 3) Purchase of Land – No report.
- 4) Portable Toilets – Ron Estep reported that the toilets were ordered. Richard Spring requested that the service be changed from once a week to twice a week.
