The meeting was called to order at 7:34 p.m. by President Bernard Ducat.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the May 19, 1983 Board meeting were read. Motion made by Carolyn Walsko, seconded by Bernard Ducat to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried 3-0.

OLD BUSINESS

- 1) Larimer Pavilion – Mrs. Walsko reported that the new pavilion is finished. Mr. Monix will do some touch up work around the pavilion. Mr. Ducat reported that he had talked to Mr. Monix about the cracks in the new concrete apron and that they should not pose any problems. After some discussion, motion made by Bernard Ducat, seconded by Ron Estep, to donate the old pavilion to Civic Park. Motion carried 3-0.
- 2) Park Signs – Mr. Estep reported that two new signs should be ready by the end of the month.

- 3) Summer Program – Mrs. Walsko reported that the summer program is working out very well.
- 4) Purchase of Land – Mr. Ducat reported that we have not heard from Mr. Catlow. Mr. Ducat recommended that we terminate the Catlow property deal and look elsewhere.
- 5) Larimer Pond – Mr. Ducat reported that the Lake County Health Department was out this week and took water samples from all the ponds in St. John. The Health Department will submit a report to us when their research is complete.
- 6) Other Old Business – Mr. Estep reported that the landscaping and well installation in Homestead Park is completed. Mr. Estep will contact the Indiana Department of Natural Resources and Wildlife and get some information on how to control algae.

Mr. Ducat reported that we had applied for a \$10,000.00 grant through the Small Business Administration and that our application has been denied for lack of available funds.

Mr. Ducat read a letter sent to the Lake Central School Board about the new Larimer Pavilion.
