The regular meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Ronald Estep introduced Ralph Ehresman as the newly appointed Board member. He is replacing Joel Gorelick, who recently resigned. Mr. Estep also announced that Bernard Ducat's resignation from the Board. Mr. Estep thanked Mr. Ducat on behalf of the Park Board for his many contributions over the years.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes from the last meeting were not prepared and were deleted from the agenda.

OLD BUSINESS

Park Signs – Currently Larimer Park and Homestead Park have a park sign.

Pavilion in Homestead Park – The pavilion will be constructed at the west end of Homestead Park. Mr. Estep has contacted Mr. Tomjanovich, the Carpentry Instructor at Lake Central High School, and made arrangements for the class to construct the Homestead Pavilion. The class will be responsible for the entire construction except for

the concrete and this will go to an outside contractor. The project should start in the fall of 1984.

St. John Festival 5K Race – 81 registered and 75 actual participants. Overall winner was Jeff Hupke from Lake Central High School with a time of 16:14. First female was a Mary Bohney from Lake Central High School with a time of 20:11.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business to discuss.

ASSIGNMENTS

- A. Budget – Balance of \$13,753.65. Current cash balance is \$8,272.87. 1985 Budget has not been approved yet.
- B. Fitness Program – Mr. Estep reported that the aerobic classes will start again in the fall.
- C. Park Maintenance – Bull Creek Ditch has been cleaned and dredged which has caused the water level in Homestead Park to drop three feet. Due to this water level drop, Pete Monix has been instructed to turn the pump back on to raise the water level. Mr. Monix was also instructed to put some copper sulfate in the pond to clean the scum out.
- D. Summer Program – Program is continuing in it successful fashion.
- E. Winter Program – Noting to report, but the Board is currently looking for one of its members to take over the project.
- F. Public Relations – Nothing to report.
- G. Baseball & Softball – Mr. Estep requested that the newly appointed member, Mr. Ehresman, take over this assignment.

CORRESPONDENCE

Mr. Estep read a letter from the Homewood – Flossmoor Illinois Ice Arena, offering programs for hockey and ice-skating lessons. Additional correspondence was received from Berg Christian Enterprises. They provide prize ribbons at a minimal cost.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

Carolyn Walsko made the motion to pay the bills, seconded by Ralph Ehresman.
