The meeting of the St. John Park Board was called to order by President Caroline Petrick at 8:03 p.m. in the Town Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Caroline Petrick to approve the April 20, 1989 minutes as read, with a second by Rick Conaway.

OLD BUSINESS

Signs – Mike Adams spoke with Jack Smith, after a copy of the rules was given to him. Jack Smith said he should have them done by next meeting.

Land Appraisals – Nobody has contacted us about any further development. A suggestion was made to call Mr. David Wickland.

Resolution No. 3-16-89 – Fee for reserving a pavilion was completed and given to the Clerk-Treasurer.

A suggestion was made that we contact the corresponding Regulatory Agencies, so that the Park Department could begin dredging Larimer Pond.

The Park Department is donating flowers to the Boy Scouts, and in turn the Boy Scouts are donating a little time to clean up the memorial at Larimer Park.

- Fitness Program – Aerobics will end on May 24, 1989. Pam Zych stated that she would like to do this again next year on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. A motion was made to accept her again next year by Caroline Petrick, with a second by Mike Adams. Pam Zych stated that she would like to conduct a walking class, two days a week on a six-week trial basis to see about attendance and how the class is operating. A motion was made by Caroline Petrick that we conduct a walking class. After the six weeks are up, Pam should be averaging 8 people per class not to include herself, at a cost of \$.50 per person.
- Public Relations – Nothing to report at this time.
- Liaison to the Town Board – Nothing to report at this time.
- Winter Programs – Nothing to report.
- Summer Programs – A short discussion about a safety program for the kids at the Town Festival. Check on booth space with the Festival Committee.
