The regular meeting of the St. John Park Board was called to order by President Michael Adams at 8:03 p.m. in the St. John Town Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Caroline Petrick to approve the July 16, 1990 minutes as read, with a second by Mary Anne Koke.

OLD BUSINESS

A letter has finally been received by the Town Council regarding the entrance from U.S. 41 onto Fabian's property in regard to the Central Park Project. According to the town attorney, the letter in brief stated that since there has not been a formal proposal issued to the Highway Department for an entrance onto the previously stated property, that they cannot make a formal decision as to yes or no to an entrance onto U.S. 41. But that if someone wanted to do this they would have to abide by a lot of rules and regulations in constructing the ascending and descending lanes, which would cost n the

neighborhood of \$500,000.00. There is doubt as to the economics of planning to build these ascending and descending lanes at that cost.

NEW BUSINESS

The Town Council accepted the check for \$34,200.00 as a cash donation from Clarmonite Ridge, in lieu of parkland.

Schillton Hills parkland issue will need to have a special work study session. The date will be decided upon later.

Oak Meadows developers have decided to make their park a "Private Park".

Rinck Estates for future reference will be called Valley View Estates, and the Park Department will be getting a cash donation for the eight (8) lots in the subdivision of \$250.00 per lot.

ASSIGNMENTS

Budget – Figures were not available at the time of meeting.

Fitness Program – Pam Zych had a question of the release forms being amended. Mr. Wickland will be contacted for a decision in this matter.

Liaison to Town Council – The Park Department, the Plan Commission, and Town Council will have a special study session to update Ordinance No. 637.

Town Festival – Next year the Park Department will not sponsor the Horseshoe Tournament during the festival.

Preventative Maintenance - The rules and regulations signs for the park need to be put up.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

A motion was made by Caroline Petrick, with a second from Mike Adams to bill the bills.

OPEN DISCUSSION

Stacy's Addition was introduced to the Plan Commission, and some further work is being done in Homestead at the present time.

Mrs. King submitted some names as to people we can contact to help with the algae problem in Homestead Park Pond.

ADJOURNMENT

A motion was made by Caroline Petrick to adjourn, with a second by Mary Anne Koke.
