APPROVAL OF MINUTES

OLD BUSINESS

Fairway Park – Rick Conaway to meet with Mr. Beckman about the park site moving to the detention pond with the Town Engineer to advise us as to the feasibility.

Central Park Property – Continuing on with the condemnation proceedings.

Arbor Day Celebration – Will be on Sunday, April 28, 1991, with the planting of ash trees by the Boy Scouts at Lancer and Timberlane Parks.

ASSIGNMENTS

- Budget – Mary Anne Koke made a motion to move \$2,000.00 from Line Item \$410 to #131 for the promotional fund.
- Fitness Program – Feasibility of a volleyball court at Timberlane Park was discussed.
- Liaison to Town Council – Mike Adams did not attend meeting.
- Winter / Summer Programs – None going on.
- Preventative Maintenance – No report given.
- Baseball & Softball – Representatives from Girls Softball League, Larry Franks and Kathy Kapelinski, were present and discussed their concern for the use of the baseball fields at Lake Central. Rick Conaway assured them he had been in contact with Mr. Lunger and the fields will be ready for Girls Softball. Pete will discuss with Mr. Kennedy the continued use of Security Field until they break ground for the new building. Rick made a motion to spend only \$500.00 maximum for fill at Larimer Park and Keilman Fields.
- Liaison to Plan Commission – Letter from Mr., Wickland stating that Patnoe Park can be used for ice-skating and our liability insurance will cover it.
