The regular meeting of the Parks and Recreation Board was called to order at 7:05 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mary Anne Koke made a motion to accept the minutes of the October 10th meeting. William Samuelson seconded motion. The motion passed 3-0.

OLD BUSINESS

The St. John Junior Women’s Club is asking the board to consider allowing the Club to reserve East Park Complex for a one-day Town Picnic to be held the weekend following Labor Day. The event would not be a festival or carnival, but would include various organizations from the Town.

Schillton Park – Pavilion is finished, but the railings are still missing.

Central Park – Nothing to report.

Sun Meadows Park – Driveway has been paved.

Candlelight Park – Pavilion is finished, but the railings are still missing.

NEW BUSINESS

Calton Landscaping has offered trees at fifty percent off for the Parks. Mary Anne Koke made a motion to spend up to \$500.00 for trees from Calton Landscaping. William Samuelson seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0.

ASSIGNMENTS

Budget – The Board has approximately \$20,000.00 in our bank account.

Fitness:

- Fit Kids Program – average attendance 15, money collected \$250.00
- Volleyball, average attendance 18, money collected \$185.00
- Dance Aerobics – average attendance 23, money collected \$463.00
- Basketball – average attendance 11, money collected \$129.00
- Total money collected \$1,027.00.

Public Relations – Thank you letters have been sent out.

Liaison to Town Council – Nothing to report.

Winter / Summer – Program started. William Samuelson made a motion to direct the Public Works Department to install volleyballs at Fairway and Sun Meadows Parks. Mary Anne Koke seconded motion. The motion passed 3-0.

Maintenance – Nothing to report.

Baseball / Softball / Soccer – St. John Evangelist Church wants to use East Park Complex as their home field.

Liaison to Plan Commission – White Oak Manor (Patnoe Park continuation), has been leveled but not graded or seeded.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

A bill has been received from Site Services for \$2,965.00 for paving the drive at Sun Meadows Park. The monies will come from the escrow account deposited by the developer.
