- 1) Prairie West Pond, Candlelight Subdivision, West 93rd Avenue
- 2) Louis Pond, Louis Estates, Olcott Avenue and Louis Drive
- 3) Homestead Acres Pond, Homestead Acres, South on Olcott Avenue

Joan Millis explained the three-(3) proposals as follows:

1. [McNamara Aquatic Weed Control, Valparaiso, Indiana](#)

- (a) One time treatment three ponds - \$2,400.00
- (b) Maintenance Program through September - \$3,750.00
- Total cost of \$6,150.00

2. RWR Tech Services, Valparaiso, Indiana

- (a) One time treatment three ponds - \$2,800.00
- (b) Maintenance Program through September - \$65.00/hour and chemical cost plus 15%
- Total cost unknown

3. Aquatic Control, Seymour, Indiana

- (a) One time treatment three ponds - \$2,515.50
- (b) Maintenance Program through September - \$4,126.50
- Total cost of \$6,642.00

- Motion by Mary Anne Koke, seconded by Eileen Butcher, to go ahead and treat all three ponds (Homestead, Prairie West and Louis) having McNamara Aquatic Weed Control do the treatments both the one time treatment and the maintenance programs for a total cost of \$6,150.00. Passed unanimously.
